VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

Thank you for applying for a 24-7 Mission Team this Summer. This form sets out the responsibility from 24-7 Prayer and yourself, if you are successful in your application to join us on a mission team:

- What 24-7 Prayer undertakes
- The guidelines we ask you to observe.

Please read it carefully before signing the form. Some element of risk is unavoidable, but we aim to work together to minimise it as far as possible.

24-7 PRAYER WILL:

- Endeavour to give you all the information necessary, so far as it is available, to enable you to prepare adequately for your team.
- Undertake to provide all reasonable supervision of your team, particularly where community outreach is involved, to minimise any risks. Safety, and health advice will be provided as part of the orientation on arrival.
- Arrange travel, health and personal insurance to cover your trip (the cost of this is included in the team fee for team members from the EU; an additional premium may be payable for team members from outside the EU).
- Give general guidance on common sense healthcare before and during the team. For specific advice you should consult your GP.
- 24-7 Prayer team leaders reserve the right and have full authority to take whatever sanctions (including repatriation) are felt necessary in respect of any team member who, by their attitude or behaviour, endangers the safety, health, unity or well-being of their team, or whose behaviour gives offence to nationals. Such action will normally only be taken after discussion with the **individual concerned and after consultation with the team leader.**

IN RETURN, I CONFIRM MY AGREEMENT TO THE FOLLOWING:

- To recognise the authority of leaders, both of 24-7 Prayer and in the local situation, and to follow their instructions and advice.
- To take care at all times to safeguard the health and safety both of yourself and other members of the team, especially through standards of hygiene and responsible behaviour.
- To read and adhere to the safety guidelines set out in the orientation booklet.
- To be sensitive to the local culture in such areas as dress, body language, music and boy/girl relationships to avoid giving offence and endangering relationships with the local people.
- Not to smoke, drink alcohol or take recreational drugs at any time during the team (this is the expected norm but in some cultural situations, light social drinking may be allowed at the discretion of the local leaders).
- That for the duration of the trip, all relationships must be kept on a friendly team-spirited basis and that there will be no exclusive relationships (i.e. same gender friendships, romantic relationships) on the team or at the project (with the obvious exception of married couples!)

- Not to travel independently, or leave the main group, while on the team without the clear permission of the team leader.
- I will endeavour not to jeopardise the partnership between 24-7 Prayer and the local communities by my actions, behaviour and attitude

Having read the above conditions

- i. I agree to comply with them at all times on the 24-7 Prayer Team. I am in full sympathy with the aims of the team and I undertake to respect the authority of the leaders of my team. I commit myself to the work of the team and to the wellbeing of my fellow team members and hosts at all times. I will act in the best interests of the team and the aims and objectives of the mission.
- ii. I declare that I have not been convicted or cautioned for any offences (other than minor motoring offences) or am not at present the subject of criminal charges **OR** I have declared any offences past or present to 24-7 Prayer in writing as part of my initial application.
- iii. I understand that 24-7 Prayer will retain my details in a private and confidential manner as set out in the GDPR Act 2018, and will only be passed on to relevant third parties for the practical purposes of this trip, i.e. my team leader, team members or representatives.
- iv. I have read the document containing practical information in relation to the 24-7 Prayer team and will ensure that payment is made as specified to cover the costs of the team. I understand that 24-7 Prayer are not responsible to cover costs other than those specified and that these are my responsibility.
- v. I have not been advised by my GP not to travel to the team destination and understand that if I should receive such advice before the team start date, I will not be able to join the team.
- vi. I understand that 24-7 Prayer leaders reserve the right to send me home at any time and at my own expense, should such disciplinary action be required.
- vii. I agree to 24-7 Prayer contacting my emergency contact should the need arise, for example should I become ill or be involved in an emergency situation, or should difficulties arise whilst I am overseas.
- viii. I understand that I join the 24-7 Prayer team as a volunteer and that no contract of employment exists between myself and 24-7 Prayer.
- ix. I grant to 24-7 Prayer all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by 24-7 Prayer during the mission team, including any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.
