#### **Key Responsibilities:**

Managing a young and active team:

- Chairing, developing, and expanding the 24-7 Prayer GB team.
- Line managing the 24-7 Prayer Youth Director, Prayer Spaces in Schools National Team Leader and GB Prayer Room and Marketing Lead.
- Setting the GB communications strategy, in collaboration with the GB Prayer Room and Marketing Lead, inputting articles, interviews, and prayers when needed.
- Connecting regularly with 24-7 Scotland National Prayer Coordinator, inputting into 24-7 Scotland's strategy and looking for areas of collaboration.
- Developing future leaders in England and Wales.

Stirring up prayer, mission and justice across Great Britain:

- Initiate, envision, support, and oversee prayer initiatives nationally.
- Plan and coordinate appropriate gatherings, workshops, and resource evenings in GB to engage churches.
- Develop new resources alongside the GB team which will inspire, teach, and catalyse prayer in the nation.



#### Representing 24-7 Prayer Great Britain:

- Developing relationships with key churches, organisations, and leaders across GB.
- Continuing and developing GB Partnerships with other Christian organisations.
- Teaching/preaching at, as well as attending events on 24-7 Prayer's behalf.
- Representing 24-7 GB in the Global 24-7 Prayer team and reporting to the International Prayer Team.

#### Sitting on 24-7 Prayer's HOST (Heads Of Strategic Teams):

- Attending online and in-person meetings to report on the activity of 24-7 GB.
- · Reporting to Trustees and inputting into budgets for GB activities.
- Participating in GB fundraising activity, including the relaunch and development of Church Mission Partners, our network of giving churches, alongside the Head of Fundraising.
- Connecting with the 24-7 Prayer GB & Ireland Communities Team and seeking ways to communicate, support, and collaborate.

- Overseeing and/or helping to deliver 24-7 Prayer National Gatherings and European and Global Gatherings.
- Attending 24-7 Prayer events, such as the Annual Gathering, Wildfires festival, and the annual Euro Leaders' Training weekend.
